## 2 Product information

### 2.1 Intended use

#### 2.1.1 Areas of use

The Advantix height adjustment piece can be cut to length corresponding to the height of the floor construction, allowing for tile-level mounting of an Advantix grate.

Depending on the sealing of the drain, a backflow seal is inserted.

#### 2.1.2 Media

- The short-term temperature of the wastewater may reach up to 95° C. The temperature must be considerably lower in constant operation.
- The pH value must be higher than 4 but lower than 10.

It is not permitted to introduce wastewater which would damage the product material.

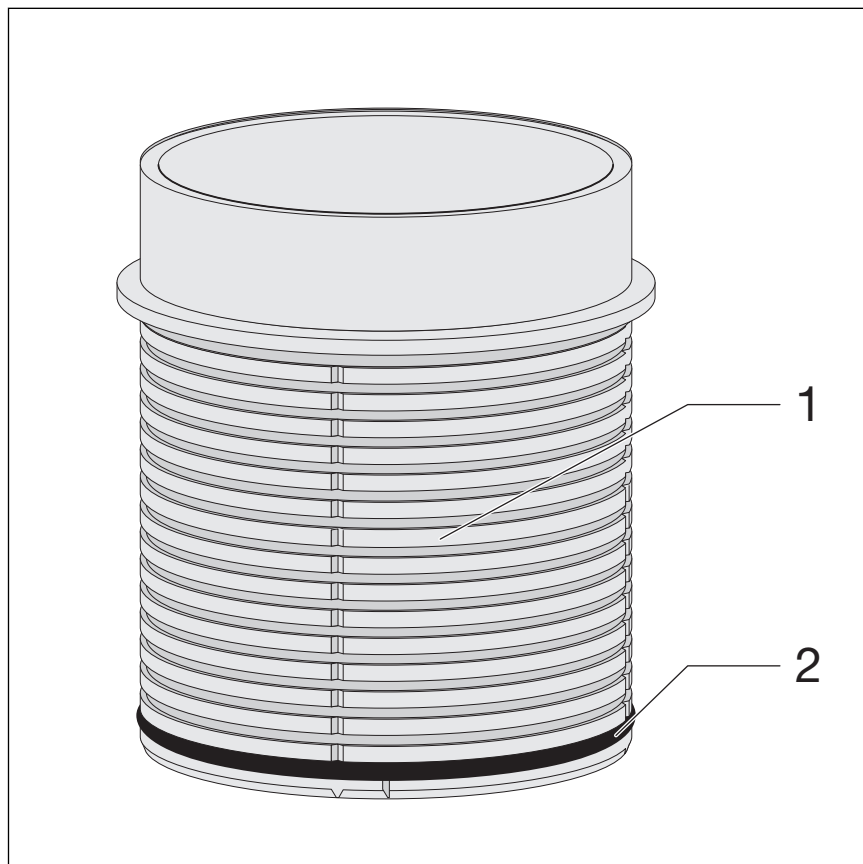


Fig. 1: Scope of delivery

#### 3.1.1 Installation dimensions

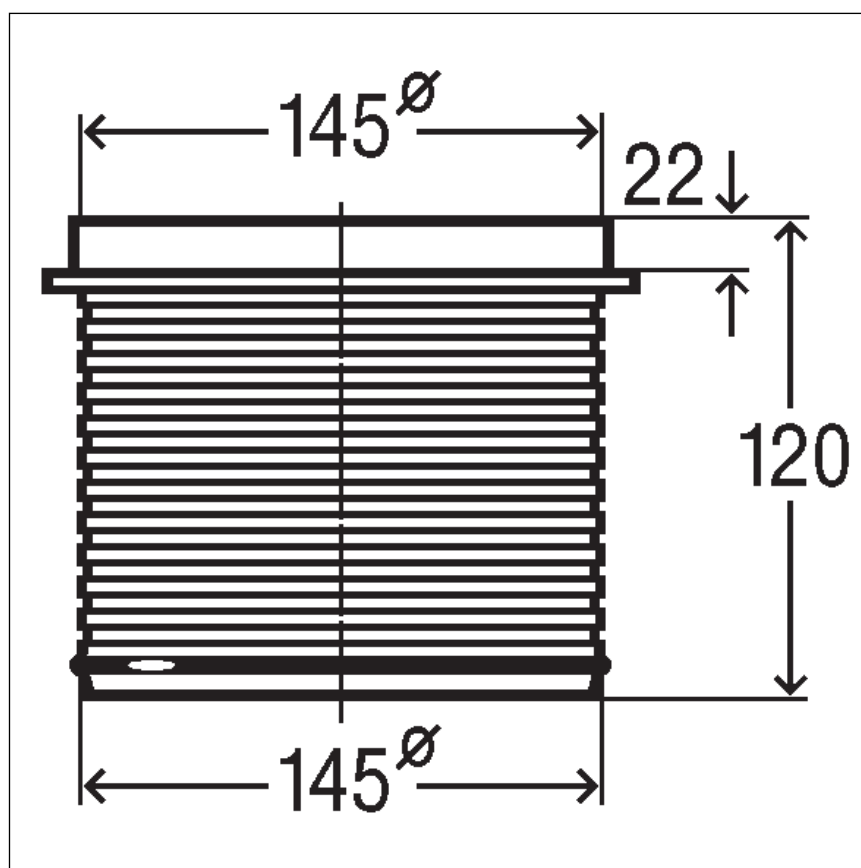


Fig. 2: Dimensional drawing

##### Required tools

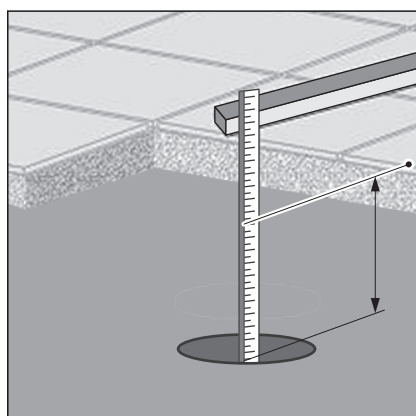
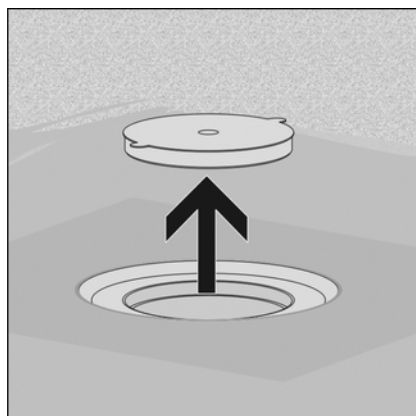
- Hand saw (saw blade maximum 1.5 mm)

##### Required material

- Advantix grate

## 3.2 Assembly

### Cutting the height adjustment piece to length



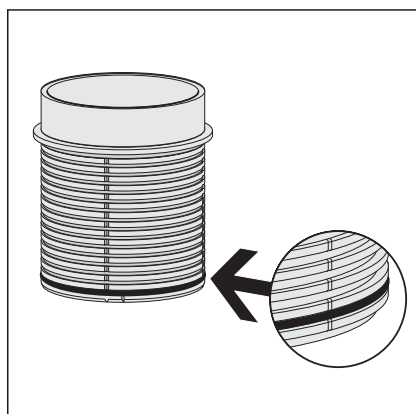
Requirements:

- The drain has been mounted and sealed.
- Remove yellow protective plug.

- Calculate the height of the floor construction from the edge in the inside of the drain up to the upper edge of the tiles.

- Starting with the upper edge of the frame, transfer the measured height to the height adjustment piece.
- Cut the height adjustment piece to the marked height.

### Install backflow seal



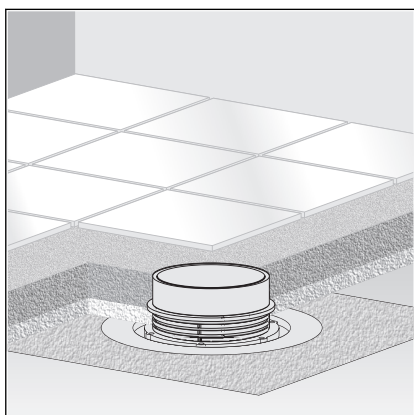
#### NOTICE!

**Water damage due to incorrect installation of a backflow seal.**

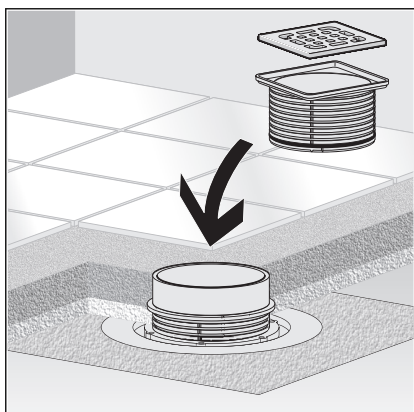
- Do not install a backflow seal if thin bed sealing is used.
- For conventionally sealed drains, a backflow seal must be employed when no dampness is supposed to flow into the drain from outside of the top but water may seep in from below. Normally, no backflow seal is mounted so that water that occurs around the frame (e. g. due to a leaky silicone joint) can flow away. In the following cases, a backflow seal must be used for conventionally sealed drains:
  - In the case of the risk of a build-up of water that can soak through the screed.
  - When a stacking element is mounted for the thin bed sealing (see instructions for use for the stacking element).

- If necessary, insert backflow seal in the lowest notch of the height adjustment piece.

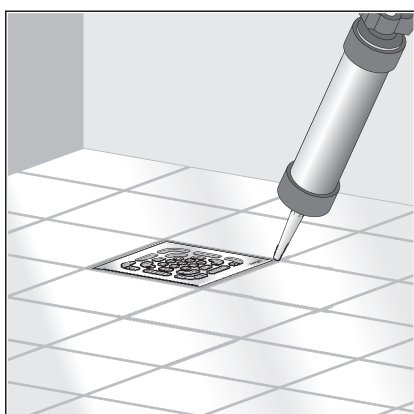
### Inserting the height adjustment piece



- Place the height adjustment piece into the drain.
- Align the height adjustment piece with the tiles.
- Work the height adjustment piece into the screed or floor covering.



- Position the top frame and the Advantix grate on the height adjustment piece.



- Lay tiles. Keep gap between top and flange free from surface seal and tile adhesive.
- Close the gap between grate and tiles with silicone.

## 3.3 Disposal

Separate the product and packaging materials (e. g. paper, metal, plastic or non-ferrous metals) and dispose of in accordance with valid national legal requirements.
