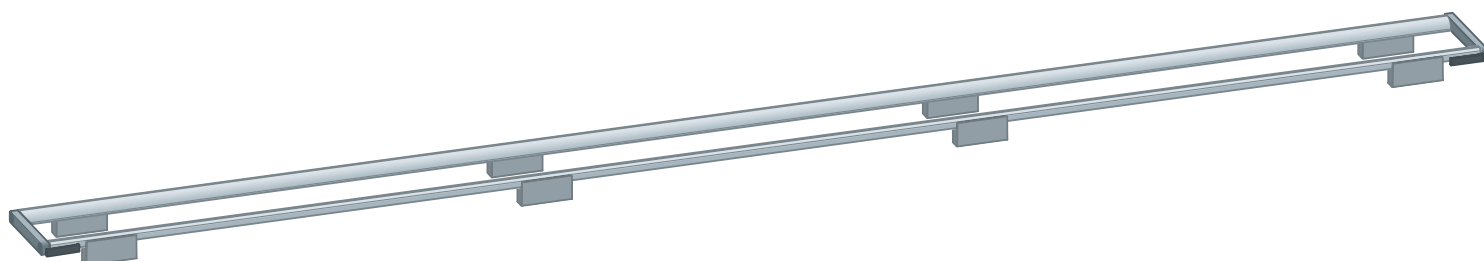

2.2 Product description

Advantix mounting frames are suitable for use in Advantix shower channels base unit model 4982.10 and 4982.20.

Advantix mounting frames are suitable for all Advantix shower channel grates with a flooring height of 8-20 mm (tile and adhesive).

Only waste water commonly encountered in households may be introduced, see  „Regulations from section: Media“ on page 5.

Observe the instructions for use of the base unit when mounting.

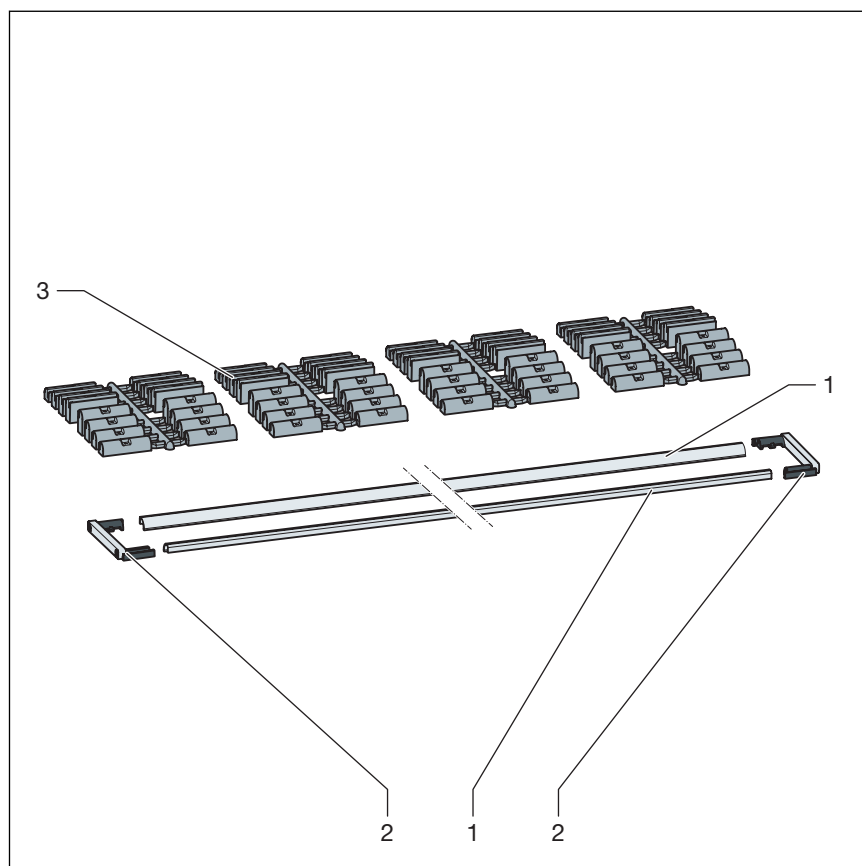


Fig. 1: Scope of delivery

3 Handling

3.1 Assembly information

3.1.1 Important note

During assembly:

- Observe installation dimensions.

After assembly:

- The shower channel must be fully lined with mortar.
- Coordinate all relevant installation details, especially regarding the bonded sealing, with those responsible for the subsequent work.

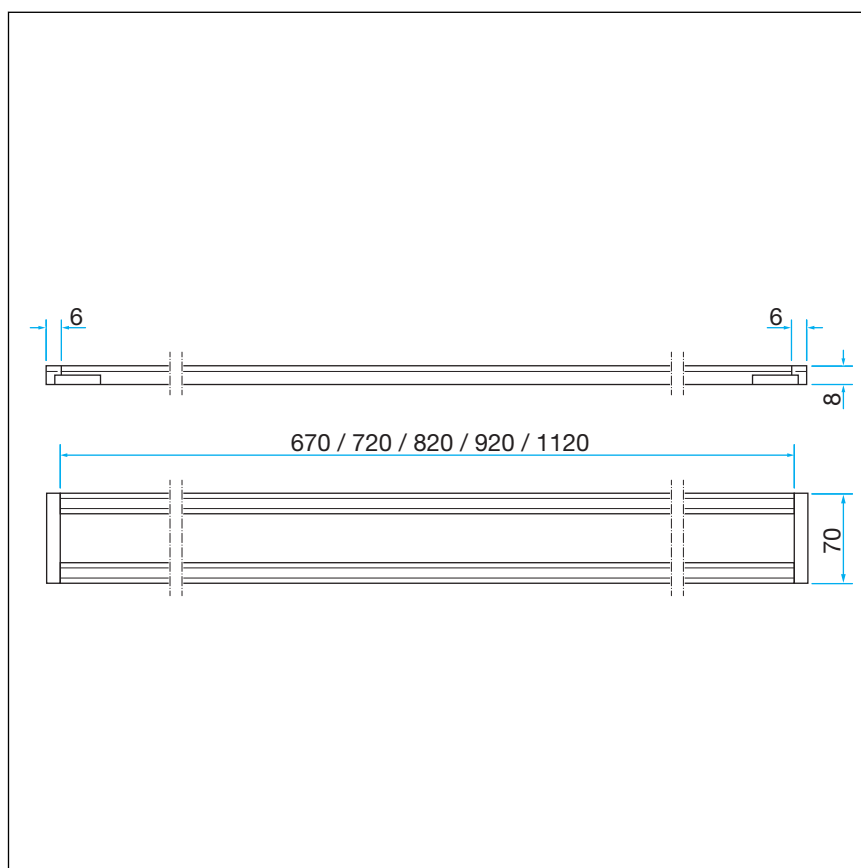


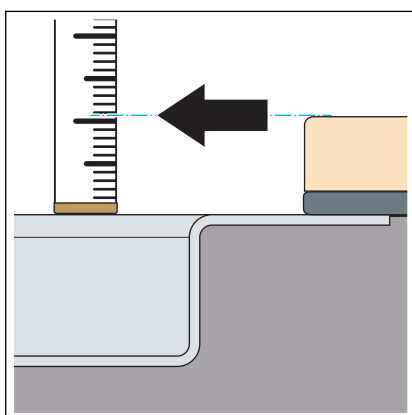
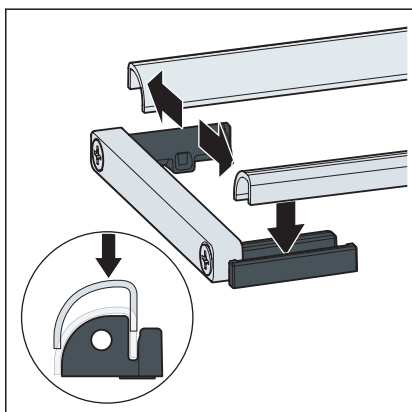
Fig. 2: Dimensions

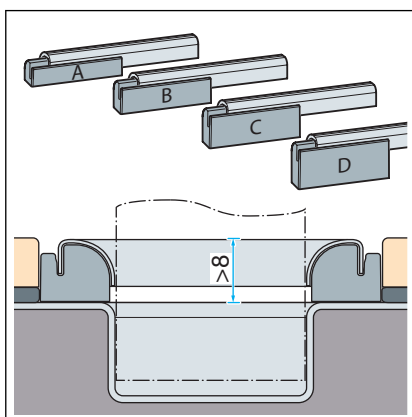
3.2 Assembly

Requirements:

- The shower channel has been mounted pursuant to the instructions for use.
- The complete surface of the shower channel has been lined.
- The shower channel has been sealed, and the bonded sealing is fully cured.
- Place the frame profiles on the head pieces so that the higher side of the frame profile is pointing inwards.
- Press the frame profiles onto the head pieces.



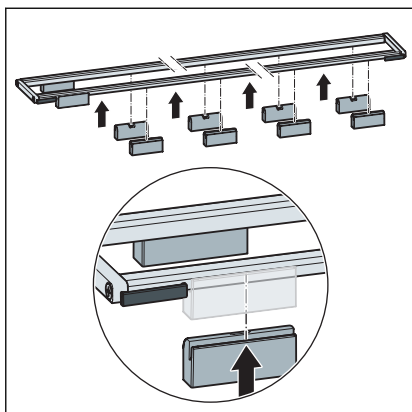
- Determine the height to the upper edge of the tiles.



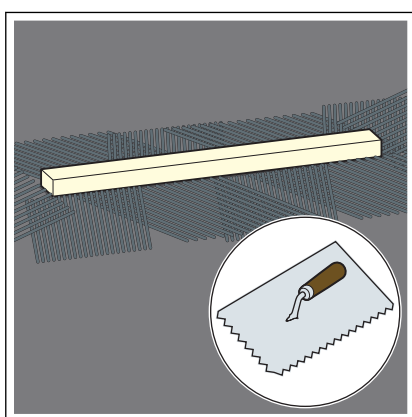
- Select the spacers.

Height up to upper edge of the frame:

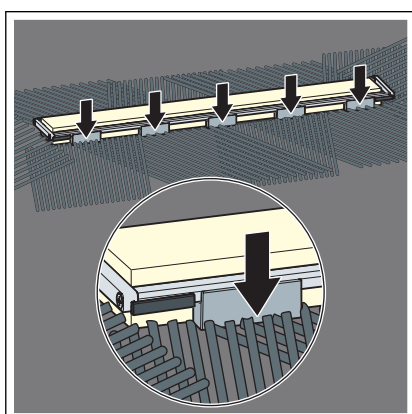
- Without 8 mm spacer
- Spacer **A** 11 mm
- Spacer **B** 14 mm
- Spacer **C** 17 mm
- Spacer **D** 20 mm



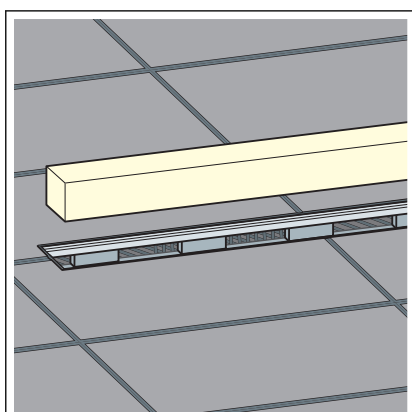
► Distribute and mount the spacers uniformly on the mounting frame.



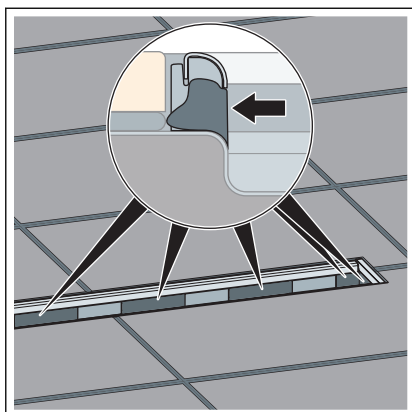
► Apply sufficient tile adhesive in the frame area.



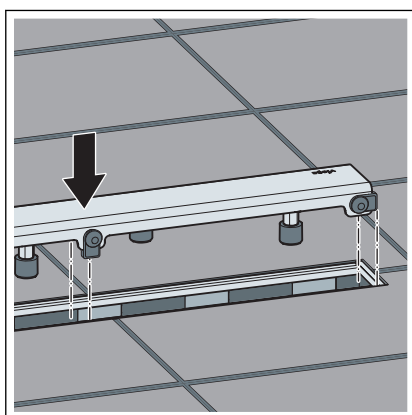
► Press the mounting frame as far as possible into tile adhesive.



► After completing the tiling work and once everything has fully hardened, remove the hard foam block.



- Seal the cavities below the mounting frame with tile adhesive or joint filler.



- To mount the grate, refer to the instructions for use for the grate.

3.3 Disposal

Separate the product and packaging materials (e. g. paper, metal, plastic or non-ferrous metals) and dispose of in accordance with valid national legal requirements.
